Course Objectives:

Digital Photography II is an advanced elective course that furthers the technical and aesthetic study of digital photography. Projects are designed to enhance students' technical knowledge and serve as inspiration to experiment with various approaches. Students will continue their study of photographers who inspire them and further develop their processing skills using Adobe Lightroom Classic CC and Adobe Photoshop CC. Assignments are designed to develop critical thinking and creative problem solving skills and encourage independent thought. Students are encouraged to refine and revise their work, as well as reflect on their process. A portfolio of artwork will continue to develop during the year.

Grading Policy

80% ASSIGNED PROJECTS

- completion & presentation of assigned projects
- each project is assessed with rubric & participation in class critique/presentation
